

- Citizens of Austin, especially the engaged residents of the neighborhoods around Mueller, have been key partners with the City, Catellus Development Group and other stakeholders from the very inception of Mueller. Indeed, many citizen participants have been part of the Mueller story ever since the Citizens for Airport Relocation (CARE) plan was crafted, largely by Mueller neighbors, in the mid-1980s.
- The nine-year Mueller master planning process involved hundreds of meetings with neighbors and other citizens, and both the City and Catellus continue to regularly meet with and get valuable input from neighbors and citizen leaders.
- The City-appointed Mueller commission (the RMMA PIAC) is currently the main venue for facilitating ongoing community involvement with the Mueller project. The RMMA PIAC meets the second Tuesday of each month, unless otherwise scheduled, beginning at 6 p.m. at the Waller Creek Center at 625 E. 10th Street.
- The Mueller Neighborhoods Coalition (MNC) is a dynamic collaboration of established neighborhoods surrounding Mueller, whose input has helped to shape the vision of the community. The MNC, which began as the Neighborhood Focus Group working with ROMA Design Group to produce the Mueller Master Plan, works closely with the City, Catellus and other stakeholders to plan events, gauge neighborhood opinion and otherwise organize the neighbors' direct and ongoing involvement with Mueller.
